

WOMAN LEADER IN NEW TURKEY

Halide Edib Hanoum Is at Forefront in Nationalist Movement Believes Western Education and Mahomet's Teachings Can Be Harmonized

Consociation, June 8.—Halide Edib Hanoum stands pre-eminent among the women of New Turkey. The Turkey created by Mustafa Kemal and his associates in the Nationalist movement.

In fact, Halide Edib Hanoum was outstanding among Turkish women through the World War as well in the days when the Sultan still sat on the throne of the Bosphorus and the new republic had not established its capital at Ankara.

Leader for 15 Years. Halide Hanoum sprang into temporary prominence for some time through her marriage to Mustafa Kemal. Her father was a doctor and when Mustafa Kemal divorced her she specifically dropped out of sight.

For 15 years Halide Edib Hanoum has been an active leader in the movement for the liberation of Turkey. She has acted out as a writer, speaker, organizer and editor. Her work has been done with women.

At a meeting held in the Hotel Concord, the Turkish Red Cross, she took a prominent position in war relief work. She was the first Turkish woman to be graduated from the American Nurses Association.

Refused to Bear Yoke. Her first marriage was an unhappy one. Her parents compelled her to marry a man who was not her choice. But, unlike most Turkish women, she did not bear the yoke patiently. She obtained a divorce.

Halide Edib Hanoum had the advantage of many years' education in France, England, Germany and Austria, and her fluency in all these languages has been translated into many foreign languages.

Blinded Capture. When the British, French and Italian took over the entire administration of Constantinople in 1921 and closed the Turkish Parliament, she was one of the first Nationalists the foreign troops attempted to capture.
